significant sportspeople, including local


athletes who have competed in the Olympics.

We will be programming, learning about algorithms and debugging during the term. We will even have a go at stop motion.




Summer Term in Rainforest Class

In Music we will learn about different instruments and symbols. We will listen to pieces of music and learn how to appraise.

We will start by learning about citizenship in PSHE before moving onto economic wellbeing, with a focus on money after half term.

In Science we are starting the term looking at animals, recognising differences and similarities. We will then move onto plants; identifying what they need to grow, where they grow and identifying common flowers and trees.

In English this first half term we will be looking at Stories from Other Cultures, Explanation Texts and Poetry. In the second half term we will be looking at Letters and Postcards and Stories by the same author. Some of our writing will link with other areas of our curriculum too.



Our DT this half term will link to our learning about South Africa. We will be weaving, creating sunset pictures and making masks to name a few activities. In Art we will be looking at landscapes, cityscapes and seascapes and learning about different artists such as David Hockney and Van Gogh.
