School Building Improvement Work

It has been very busy at Bradleys Both for the full six weeks of the Summer holiday. You may have seen the skips, contractors and heard all kinds of noises coming from the building over the holiday! Following a successful joint bid by our school and YCAT we were awarded additional capital funding from the DfE's Condition improvement Fund (CIF). This funding has been used to improve our school buildings for the future with particular focus on fire safety.



The work started on the first day of the school holiday where the internal classroom partitions glazing and doors were replaced. At one point in the holiday, school was looking rather 'open plan' with the walls and partition walls all taken down. In addition new fire detection and emergency lighting has been installed along with a brand new fire alarm system.





We have returned to a smart 'new' school building that we are all very proud of; I always think that when we work in a school we are there to look after it for a period of time and sustain it for the future. The staff team and particularly Bela our caretaker and cleaner have been fantastic in working so hard to get school clean and ready to open for this week. I hope you will be able to see the difference the work has made next time you visit school.
